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MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT/CFO

Climate change is real. We're seeing more and more evidence of this every year, in weather patterns and significant weather events. The increasing severity of storms is becoming ever more apparent.

Atlantic Canada suffered through Hurricane Fiona in September of 2022. That storm was unquestionably the event of the year for our organization. We were still in the middle of our Fall planting season when Fiona hit Canada, and the hurricane caused massive damage. It also caused significant disruptions to daily life. Some people went without power for a full month. Remarkably though, we were able to complete all of our planned planting work, despite almost insurmountable logistical challenges.

Our planting team for 2022 did wonderful work. They rose to the challenge of tackling project sites in a variety of provinces, and made everything come together with poise and professionalism.

The continuation of our Parks planting program is unquestionably one of the highlights of 2022, although our carbon plantation work also expanded significantly compared to 2021. We also worked on several restoration projects, including two new bird sanctuaries that are currently in development.

Thanks for taking the time to review this 2022 Annual Report. We look forward to expanding our operations and continuing our work in 2023.

OUR RESTORATION PROJECTS

In 2022, these were our three main restoration projects:

Luciphy East Bird Sanctuary – We planted 24,558 trees in this new project in New Brunswick, where One Tree Planted was the lead proponent and sponsor of the project.

Upper Aboushagan Bird Sanctuary – We planted 25,361 trees in this new project in New Brunswick, where One Tree Planted was the lead proponent and sponsor of the project.

Fort Folly First Nation – We planted 6,319 trees at this Mi'kmaq First Nation, which were funded by Larrek and additional public donors.

We also continued our work on shelterbelt projects in Saskatchewan.

OUR PUBLIC PARK PROJECTS

In 2022, we participated in tree planting programs in the following public parks:

Acadien Village Provincial Park – We planted 36,028 trees in this park in New Brunswick, where One Tree Planted was the lead proponent and sponsor of the project.

Mactaquac Provincial Park – We planted 32,963 trees in this park in New Brunswick, where Trees For Life was the lead proponent and sponsor of the project.

Hopewell Rocks Provincial Park – We planted 15,044 trees in this park in New Brunswick, where Trees For Life was the lead proponent and sponsor of the project.

Murray Beach Provincial Park – We planted 5,189 trees in this park in New Brunswick. TreeEra was the lead proponent for the project and sponsored the planting of 3,800 trees. We also planted an additional 1,389 trees that were funded by various public and corporate sponsors.

Republique Provincial Park – We planted 16,085 trees in this park in New Brunswick, where Trees For Life was the lead proponent and sponsor of the project.

New River Beach – We planted 16,105 trees in this park in New Brunswick, where Trees For Life was the lead proponent and sponsor of the project.

Fundy Trail Parkway – We planted 20,199 trees in this park in New Brunswick, where Trees For Life was the lead proponent and sponsor of the project.

Terra Nova National Park – We planted 2,400 trees in this park in Newfoundland, funded by various public and corporate sponsors.

Victoria Park – We planted 51,305 trees in this municipal park in Truro, Nova Scotia, where One Tree Planted was the lead proponent and sponsor of the project.

We expect to be planting in several municipal, provincial, and national parks in 2023, including a pair of very challenging rugged remote access national parks. We're looking forward to it!

OUR CARBON PLANTATION PROJECTS

A portion of our work in 2022 involved planting trees on carbon capture properties. These carbon plantations are properties which are reserved solely for carbon sequestration. We plant a diverse species mix on these plantations with the intent that they will be allowed to grow to maturity, and then remain undisturbed in perpetuity.

In 2022, we planted a total of 352,416 trees on carbon plantation projects. Some of these sites were sponsored by large organizations that acted as lead proponents, and other sites were made possible through the support of a number of public and corporate sponsors.
